For the General Public and Hobbyist Groups

- Tours are generally given on Fridays at 1:PM as well as Saturdays, at 10:AM and 1:PM. Tours may be scheduled at other times at the mutual convenience of the Military Vehicle Technology Foundation and the organizing party.
- Tours are generally given to groups of around 30 people. Small groups are combined with other small groups to make one large group tour.
- This is an active, walking tour, spread over 5 buildings and several acres.
- Tours of the collection last approximately 2+ hours.
- All tours are arranged well in advance. E-mail correspondence is preferred.
- Generally, tours are not suitable for young children, however special accommodations can be made. Please advise us as to the age demographic of your group (if under 12 years old) so we can accommodate your group properly.
- All groups will receive a confirmation e-mail approx. 1 week prior to the tour date. A reply with a solid number of tour members in your group would be appreciated.

For Business and Industry:

- Team-building and general-interest tours are available mid-week, by prior arrangement.
- For armed services and defense industry groups, access to the collection for training on specific vehicles or systems is available. Please contact the MVTF to inquire about fees and scheduling visits.
- Researchers are encouraged to contact the foundation for special access to the collection.
